Directions to Parking @ Boulder Reservoir
FROM DENVER: Hwy 36 all the way through Boulder. Turn right on Jay Rd. Left on 51st. North to Boulder Reservoir Entrance.
FROM FORT COLLINS: Hwy 287 South. Right turn onto Hwy 66. Left onto 95th (Hover Rd). Right turn Hwy 119 (Diagonal Hwy). Right on Jay Rd. Right on 51st. North to Boulder Reservoir Entrance. Please don't drive on course.
FROM GOLDEN: Hwy 93 to Boulder. Right on Baseline. Left on 28th. Right on Jay Rd. Left on 51st. North to Boulder Reservoir Entrance.

Entry Fees to Boulder Reservoir
Entry to Boulder Reservoir is free before 9AM. After 9AM, entrance fees are \$5/person or \$10/car.

Feed Zone
Located just east of the START/FINISH line at the Boulder Reservoir.

Race Rules: All USAC & Collegiate Rules Apply

- **USAC Release waiver** must be signed by all racers or parent/guardian for anyone 18 years or younger.
- **USAC license required for all USAC events.**
- **USAC Beginner 1-day license:** \$15, (Can purchase online when registering.) Men and Women who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category in the discipline they are registering for.

USAC Experienced 1-day license: \$35, If your categories prohibit you from entering a race with a beginner one-day license (cat 1 mountain bike and anything but cat 5 for road, track and cyclo-cross), you can purchase the experienced one-day license for \$35. The experienced one-day license is only available through BikeReg.com.

Collegiate License Required in Collegiate Events.

* Only members holding an annual license residing in Colorado are eligible for the championship title.

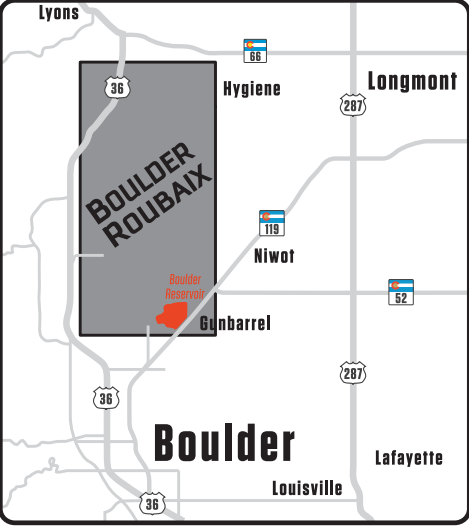

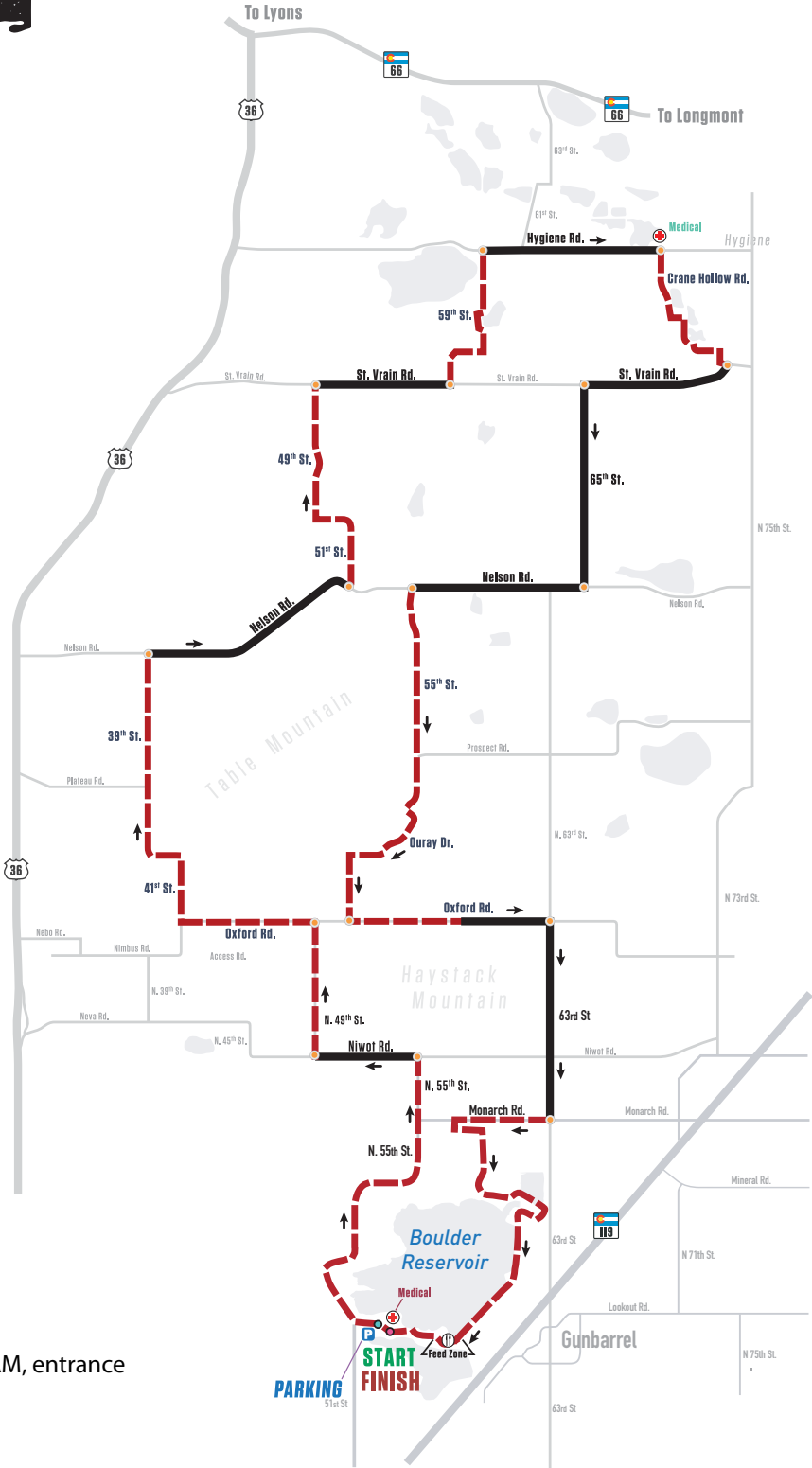
